Course Description:

The class will focus on two main activities each day. Every morning session is dedicated to one particular topic. After a one hour lecture by a faculty participant, the LMU and Chinese students will break into small groups of five or six students each for discussion. After forty minutes of exchange, the whole class assembles and each group makes a short oral report.

The afternoon session consists of visiting religious sites in Guangzhou, including Buddhist and Daoist monasteries, Sacred Heart Cathedral, and a Protestant church. Each student will write a joint report with a Chinese classmate for a final assignment.

No language requirement.
